2016 Senior All Night Party Information Sheet

May 13th 2016 - Bus sign ups (in the commons during both lunches 10:30-1:00)

Each student must check in on May 13th and reserve a spot on the bus. You will have the opportunity to choose a bus with your friends. Bus colors will be blue, white, green, orange, purple, red and yellow, **you may not sign up for a bus on May 13th unless you have paid in full and turned in all your forms. All payments and forms must be turned in by May 1st. Our committee has been emailing students that are missing forms and/or payment – please check your email to make sure you haven't' received anything from us. If you are unable to sign-up on May 13th, please email Colleen Volk at ncvolk@gmail.com to make other arrangements.**

June 13th 2016 – Graduation and All Night Party

The all-night party will happen right after graduation from Safeco Field. Please read following instructions.

■ CHECK IN AND ARRANGING FOR YOUR TRANSPORTATIOPN: Graduation will be Safeco Field. There will be some time right after graduation for our seniors to spend some time with family for pictures. Please have your parents bring a change clothes for you to the graduation (Safeco will be doing bag checks so make sure you have bags that they can see in easily so we don't slow down the security checks). The seniors will change clothes in the bathroom after they take pictures with family (comfortable shorts, jeans and tennis shoes — no flip flop or sandals) and then head to the buses for our All Night Party. All the buses will be lined up on Occidental Ave (on the side of the big parking garage), please show up to busses around 10:30pm. We will return at approximately 5:00 AM on Saturday 6/13 to Issaquah High School. For safety purposes graduates will not be allowed to drive themselves home after the all-night event. Please plan on picking up your graduate at Issaquah High School!

If something unexpected happens that day and you cannot attend the event, call Colleen Volk at 425-503-0014 by 5:00 PM. Please leave a detailed message or send a text if there is no answer so we can account for your student. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide refunds.

■ EVERY SENIOR WILL GO THROUGH A SECURITY CHECK BEFORE GETTING ON THE BUS: A pat-down will be conducted by a same-sex parent volunteer. Shoes, hats, packets, personal items will all be inspected. Prohibited items (see below) will be confiscated and stored in a bag with your name on it. If it isn't contraband, it will be returned the following morning when you get off the bus back at the high school. Anyone refusing the pat down will not be allowed to board the bus.

ANYONE DISPLAYING INAPPROPRIATE OR DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR, or believed to be in possession or under the influence of drugs or alcohol, will not be allowed to board the bus and/or removed from the event. Parents will be called to pick up their senior. If parents are unavailable, police will be contacted and no refunds will be giving. This is true for the entire evening. Good conduct will make for a carefree night.

<u>Leave the following items at home – hands free is worry free!</u>

- Cell phone (in case of emergency, parent chaperones will have phones)
- Beverage bottles or any food items if you have a severe food allergy please contact Colleen Volk
- No Drugs, alcohol, tobacco products of any kind
- No Electronics You will not have any time to use them and there is no way to ensure their safety
- Cameras. Photographer Krista Mui will be capturing the event the entire evening.
- Purses (personal hygiene items, first aid, mints and gum will be available in the restrooms or from a chaperone)

Emergency Medicine: Bring your epi-pen, inhaler, insulin or other emergency medication in prescription pharmacy packing, only if the items have been previously noted on your release. You may hold on to your own emergency medication. The volunteer nurse will have over the counter medications available by request (aspirin, Advil etc.)

Gluten-Free Students – please send an email to Colleen Volk and let her know if your student is GF. We will have food available for GF but we need a head count for this.

Wear Comfortable clothing: it will be an active evening and comfortable clothing/shoes are recommended.

Check-in Procedures: Please arrive at bus area at 10:30pm outside of Safeco Field on Occidental by the side of the parking garage. Students much check in at the check in table arranged by bus color. Students will be given a wristband with your bus color to wear all evening. Only IHS graduates with wristbands that match their bus color will be allowed on each bus. We are unable to switch bus assignments that evening. Please find your bus color and stand in line for check in, wrist bands and the pat-down. Buses will depart at 10:50 for our first location.

A professional police security officer will be present at the venues throughout the evening.

Parent chaperones will ride the buses with the seniors and are available at each venue. Please feel free to approach them if you have a question, have a friend with a medical issue, need access to check in items or just say "hi". Each venue will be staffed by event people to run activities and answer questions.
