

What is the Booster Club?

- Issaquah High school Booster Club is a 501c3 organization made up of volunteers that provides financial support to the extra-curricular activities at Issaquah High School
- IHS Boosters support programs that happen OUTSIDE of the classroom:
ALL IHS sports, clubs, and activities, including co-curriculars like band
- Boosters is a fundraising organization that benefits IHS students by providing financial support to programs through Grants
- Boosters provides clubs & sports to ability to fundraise for their program
- Boosters promotes IHS programs through social media, E-news, public signage

The Role of Boosters at Issaquah

- Provide financial support the sports, clubs and activities whenever we can!
 - Grants for equipment, uniforms, travel and more
 - Provide an easy way for programs to fundraise
- We promote IHS programs & students through:

- Over \$75,000 awarded to programs in the last 4 years. In an average year, we award approximately \$25,00 to IHS Programs
