FAQs for back to school in August 2021

ASB card: ASB Cards are an important purchase for students. Purchasing an ASB card is required for any student joining a club or sport. It also allows students free entrance into home sporting events. Purchase an ASB card online during RSVP through our online purchasing system.

Bell Schedules: Our bell schedules are posted on our website. Occasionally we have half days, weather related late start, etc. Special schedules always get updated on our website throughout the school year under upcoming events. Buses: Students will be mailed a card identifying their bus route prior to the start of school. The link/info will also be sent out in Enews/Email and posted on our website.

Class Schedules: Student schedules will be available to view on August 24th through student access. At this time the schedule will not show teachers or periods/order as we are still balancing class sizes as we enroll numerous new students in August. At this time, the process to request edits will also be sent out and posted on our website at this time. Detailed schedules with teachers, periods and room numbers will available the afternoon before the 1st day of school in student access.

Clubs: Clubs will advertise their own meeting dates/times/locations in the first few weeks of school. Listen to announcements, look out for Canvas announcements, and watch iVision for details for each club. In addition to this, we will have a Club Fair early in the school year during Nest time! Students will learn information about all of our clubs and find out how to join!

Lockers: Students can request a locker at our attendance office window just around the corner from our main office doors (where athletics, ASB and attendance windows are located). Students can come before school, during lunch, during Nest or afterschool to get a locker once school is back in session. Students should first walk through their schedule to decide the best location/hallway for a locker. Once a locker is issued, the location cannot be changed. Lockers are free, however, there is a charge for students who fail to clean out their locker at the end of the school year.

Lunches: Lunches will be based on your 4th period teacher on M, W, Th, F and based on your 5th period teacher on Tuesdays. Teachers will notify all students of their lunches on the first day of school in class.

Nest time: Nest time is time on block days (Tuesday & Wednesday). The school website will publish the Nest calendar for the year before the 1st day back to school. Nest time is spent doing one of the following activities:

- School wide activities (assemblies, safety drills, required surveys, etc.)
- Non-classroom based learning (college/career planning, counseling support, social/emotional learning)
- Choice time: help from teachers, makeup work from absences, complete HW to reduce HW time after school

Picture day: Picture day is Thursday, September 2nd. Forms will be available at the start of school.

Sports: Fall sports [registration is OPEN](#) now. Fall sports are: Cross Country (boys & girls), Diving (girls), Football (boys & girls), Golf (boys), Soccer (girls), Swimming (girls), Tennis (boys), and Volleyball (girls). Interested in participating in any of the fall sports, mark your calendars for August 1st to review all of the athletic information and start the process of fall sports registration. Incoming freshmen will need a physical dated AFTER June 1st - it's a good idea to take care of that over summer and have it ready to go!

Textbooks: Students will checkout all of their textbooks on Thursday, September 2nd during their English class.
