Working with Underrepresented Students

Issaquah High School is committed to increasing the academic achievement of special education, low income, ELL, and Hispanic students by increasing the number of students that meet standard on state and district exams and meet other graduation requirements.

In order to increase the academic achievement for these students, Issaquah High School is focused on the following three goals:

- School and Family Connections: To reach out to families in our school community to help them
 feel connected to Issaquah High School and know that they are a part of the Issaquah High
 School Community.
 - a. Home and Family Visits: A counselor/teacher pair will set up home visits with families of our underrepresented populations as well as those of other students. Visits can take place at the family's home, at a community location like a coffee shop, or at school.
 - b. The visits will focus on the hopes and dreams of students, how we can better help students at school, and welcome families to IHS.
 - c. Staff will bring a welcome packet and translators will be invited for families who need interpretation.
 - d. Visits will be kept to 30 minutes and teachers will be paid one hour for each visit which should include prep time, travel time, and meeting time. We want to include at least 16 teachers to participate in these visits. Training will be provided for these staff members around Cultural Competency and strategies for working with families.
- **Summer Enrichment Program**: To provide a summer program for students to encourage, prepare, and support success at Issaquah High School.
 - a. Issaquah High School would like to offer 1 or 2 sections of a 2 week course. One section would be for 9th graders and another section would be for 10th and 11th combined.
 - b. Students can earn .5 elective credits.
 - c. Curriculum focuses on technology, leadership, study skills, organization, healthy choices, team building, etc.
 - d. Students are provided a mobile device that they can keep throughout high school as long as certain expectations are met (completed course, attend ongoing technology training, maintain good attendance, etc.).
 - e. Students will be selected based on teacher nominations, counselor and admin approval, and student and parent commitment.

- **Technology Support and Training**: To provide training and support to students so that they can be successful at Issaquah High School and have the ability to navigate all of the technology expectations of their classes.
 - a. Issaquah High would like to offer three, 2 hour technology classes to students and a single, one hour class for parents.
 - b. Classes will be offered after school for students and in the evening for parents.
 - c. Classes will provide technology training in areas to help students access curriculum and education through technology.
 - d. The parent education class will provide training in how to access Family Access and how to navigate teacher web pages and online curriculum.
