Speaker - Erin Connolly, IHS Principal

- Covid has impacted attendance, students and teachers, at IHS.
 - Dashboard includes students that test positive when school is in session it does not include cases that tested positive while on break.
 - Student attendance last week 20% absent (also due to lockdown and field trips) and is getting better this week. Normal absentee rate is 10%.
 - Staff attendance absences being covered by other teachers, substitutes and admin. Thus far, staffing shortages does not require a building shut down.
 - Deadline for teachers to submit grades extended to 2/4 due to potential student absences.
 - Asking teachers to post lessons and resources to Canvas same-day.
 - Students struggling due to non-absence issues should talk with their individual teachers.
- Math department looking at potential changes. Identifying students who may need to change Math classes for the second semester. Looking at adding Math support classes and/or after school help.
- Summer school grade replacement available for C- and lower. Original grade stays on student's transcript, but would no longer be included in GPA calculation. Summer school details will come out in the spring.
 - Students are no longer able to take an Incomplete as their grade.
- Bullets found in bathroom last Tuesday. Went into modified lockdown due to not being an immediate threat. Investigation started immediately.
 - Next morning, received tip with threatening note. Issaquah Police Department did not feel additional lockdown mesures were needed.

- While there is a parent desire for full details, IPD and IHS don't release that info for safety reasons.
- Investigation remains on-going.
- SAT will be offered to students Wednesday, 3/23. Students will have an adjusted schedule.
- MLK assembly postponed. Will now be 2/1.
- Schedule change process is on the IHS website.
- Course registration for next year will roll out to students 3/1.
 - Incoming 9th grade sessions: 3/8, 3/9, and 3/10.
- Graduation is 6/9. Time TBD. We have the last session, historically around 7:00.
 - Do not yet know number of guests allowed per student.
 - Additional senior event dates TBD.

Speaker - Kurtis Evans, ASB Director

- Working on Covid-friendly ways students can support athletes.
- TOLO typically a dance, but will not be this year due to Covid
 - Looking for off campus venue.
 - Last week in March.
 - No guests will be allowed.
- Connection weeks promote interactions between students.
 - Hot chocolate during finals
 - Study sessions offered after school
- Prom is expected to be at MoPop on 6/4. Alex Stevens, Senior Class Advisor, works with the senior class on this.
- HOBY scholarships Hugh O'Brian Youth seminar.
 - Brings sophormores around the state together.
 - Leadership boot camp. Share ideas on ways to engage with students.
 - Grateful can send 4 sophmores with PTSA funding.
