 - Levys are approximately 15% of ISD revenue
 - o 3 measures on 4/26 ballot
 - Education Programs and Operations Levy 4-year levy
 - student services school nurses, counselors, educator salaries, mental health support, instructional coaches, 7 period day in high school, extra curricular activities, and athletics
 - academic programs special educations, ELL program, highly capable program, elementary dual language program, secondary summer school and pre-K summer school
 - support services: custodial, maintenance and repair, school safety, bus driver salaries and schoo bus fuel and maintenance
 - Capital Projects Levy 4-year levy
 - technology for students in and out of the classroom
 - equitably updated technology for schools and classrooms
 - critical repairs to schools
 - completion of high school #4
 - School Bus Levy 1-year levy
 - helps add 64 buses from 2023-2026
 - looking into grants to add electric buses to our fleet
 - the tax rate would go from \$3.51 to \$3.56/\$1000 of assessed home values district cannot collect more than total amount approved by voters
 - ESSER dollars ISD received \$7MM they are one-time funds to cover expenses associated with pandemic
 - The district will need to cut services if levies do not pass
 - Volunteers for Issaquah Schools (VIS) can donate and/or endorse levies at www.visvote.org

- Masks will not be required on buses beginning 3/14
- Will continue to try to provide distancing for lunches
- Distancing will no longer be required in classrooms
- Building will be opened at 7 AM beginning 3/14
- Volunteers are being allowed on an as-needed basis must be approved by the school
- Grading system semester grades are the only grades that go on transcripts quarter and mid-term grades are only used internally to ensure students are on the right path to obtain credit
