Motion 1: Erin Eaton moved to approve the consent agenda (October 11 meeting minutes and October financial results) as presented. Seconded. Voice vote. Motion passed.

Business

Reviewed detailed grant proposal submissions and decision guidelines. Committee-approved fall grants:

- \$44.01 LRC1 headphones
- \$170.34 for learning strategies library
- \$400.00 for Spanish 2 skit props
- \$478.28 for Chemistry table group supplies
- \$3,000.00 for Social Psychology textbooks

Additional fall grant submission:

• \$630.00 for LRC social communication lunches. Discussed this is an on-going need and the option to add the annual expense to our budget

Motion 5: Grant Committee moved to approve \$478.28 for Chemistry table group supplies. Poll vote. Motion passed.

Motion 6: Grant Committee moved to approve \$3,000.00 for Social Psychology textbooks. Poll vote. Motion passed.

Motion 7: Erin Eaton proposed to add \$1,300.00 to the PTSA budget for LRC social communication lunches. Seconded. Motion amended by Erin Eaton to change total to \$2,000.00. Seconded. Poll vote. Motion passed.

Kurtis Evans, ASB Director, shared:

- Preparing for Winter Fest decorations in Commons and halls. Culminates with Winter Fest assembly.
 - Winter Wishes There will be a tree in the main office with cards for individuals to ask for wishes. ASB, Boosters Club, and other individuals will fulfill wishes.
- Aluminum rail grant update hoping to have district carpenters install the rails, but low on the priority list. Discussed potential options for installation.
- PTSA member asked if there was anything as a community we could do for families affected by the October car accident that IHS students were involved in. Kurtis will pass the question to Admin.
- Discussed Nest and choice time. Nest was added to allow choice time for students as well as hosting assemblies to avoid loss of class time. Attendee asked if Nest assembly notifications could include more details so students who are unable to be at the assembly can discuss topics with their caregivers at home.
- Discussed speaker options for car safety as a possibility for an upcoming assembly. Discussed whether students or parents would be the appropriate audience.
