- Mission: Our mission is to build community, empower families, and advocate for students with disabilities in the Issaquah School District.
- We serve: We support ALL students with disabilities or suspected disabilities residing within the Issaquah School District boundaries, and their families.
- IEP Individualized Education Plan Plan or program developed to ensure that a child with an identified disability
 who is attending an elementary or secondary educational institution receives specialized instruction and related
 services.
- 504 plan Provides accommodations for students in need. A 504 plan is a blueprint for how the school will support a student and remove barriers to learning.
- State test scores for Special Ed students are lagging.
- Formed Special Ed PTSA so that we have a cohesive, formal organization. We want our families and students to have a voice in the Issaquah School District.
- Chartered in May 2022 with 72 members. Cover all schools and grade levels in the ISD (from ages 3-21).
- Continuing to build membership. Now have 181 members. Have members in all schools.
- Goal: Help make the IEP/504 process in the ISD more family-friendly.
