Treasurer's Report (*Erin Eaton, Pauline Tamblyn*)

- April financial results included in consent agenda. Will be filed for financial review.
- 2023-24 budget - reviewed budget details for next year. Total income = \$94,140 and total expense = \$128,530, for a projected \$34,390 loss. This draws down our existing reserves.

- **Motion 1:** Pauline Tamblyn moved to approve the budget as reviewed. Seconded. Poll vote. Motion passed.

- April meeting minutes included in consent agenda. Will be filed as presented.

Erin Connolly, Issaquah High School Principal

- AP testing is complete. Over 2000 exams were given.
- Staff voted to do Lip Dub on June 6 as a culture-building event.
- Spring sports are underway.
- Prom at MoPop on June 4.
- Graduation on June 15. Ticket prices increased due to T-Mobile price increase. Other location options were looked at, but based on space and timing needs there weren't other options for this year. Additional tickets beyond 2 are \$17. Scholarships are available.
- End-of-year assembly and movie planned for last day of school.
- Families with students with C- or lower in class will receive a notice that they need to stay on top of their grades.
- Will post information regarding the IHS student population by ethnicity and preferred language in the fall once it's available.
- Anticipate senior skip day the Monday after prom. It is not school-endorsed and attendance will still be taken, though teachers try to take it into account as they plan their lessons.
- IHS has been warmer than it should be. Reached out to maintenance to fix.
- Congratulated Riya Bathina on her Seattle Times published article.
- Discussed Running Start - student engagement and ongoing communication with students.
- Discussed the World Languages murals. IHS supports the murals and is working toward ensuring many cultures are represented.
