Motion 1: Erin Eaton moved to adopt consent agenda items as presented. Seconded by Tracy Drake. Motion passed.

Julie Carr reported on attending the WSPTA Legislative Assembly in October. Slides from her presentation were included in the Agenda deck.

Cristine Varzali reported on PTSA Grants Program. Annual budget is \$10,000. Presenting 3 options for Grants.

- 1. Matthew Fischer (student) presented grant request for a Refillable Water Station Installation near the Theater. Total project is expected to be ~\$3000. Cascade Water Alliance will donate \$2000. The request is for \$1000.
- 2. Cristine Varzali presented grant request on behalf of Helly Harel (teacher) for Outdoors for All Events. The request is for \$250 to cover the cost of bike rentals for IHS students.
- 3. Cristine Varzali presented grant request on behalf of Kinsely Krebill (teacher) for LRC II Classroom Materials, including paper shredder, 10 headphones, 2 wobble chairs and fidget toys. The request is for \$500 to cover the cost of these materials.

Motion 2: Erin Eaton moved to consider the grant for the Water Stations as submitted by Matthew. Angela Dahrea seconded. Floor was opened for discussion. Poll was taken, motion passed unanimously.

Motion 3: Julie Carr moved to consider the grant for the Bike Rentals. Seconded by Erin Eaton. Floor was opened for discussion. Poll was taken, motion passed unanimously.

Motion 4: Erin Eaton moved to consider the grant for the LRC II Classroom Materials. Seconded by Angela Dahrea. Floor was opened for discussion. Poll was taken, motion passed unanimously.
