- Very serious problem occurring with student misuse of technology
- Sexting of underage individuals is child pornography; it is a felony
- Officer requests parents help in educating their children about the seriousness and consequences of this behavior; many students are naïve about this issue
- 85% time it is secondary to use of drugs and alcohol
- Receiving such an image is not an offense-just delete it and best to notify the authorities
- <u>Do not keep possession of such an image</u>
- Forwarding such an image is a crime a felony
