Treasurer's Report---Tara Moe

- Financial update
 - March financial report
 - Income: Membership (\$185), PTH (\$300), Corporate Matching (\$175) and AmazonSmile (\$47), and Senior Events (\$28,000)
 - Expenses: Grants (\$2400), Student Food Fund (\$200), Angel (\$560), and Mock Test Room Rental (\$220)

- Discussed ISF Auction donation ISF has asked each school to donate something to the auction discussed using already budgeted ISF donation budget to fund this.

- Total members = 836 exceeded last year's total members (829)
- Membership Committee met looked at current offerings and recommends offering the following memberships next year: individual (\$15), family (\$25), staff (\$10), and student (\$10)
 - Need to understand the budget impact of offering the individual membership
 - Discussed removing the Community Partnership option and potentially looking at Community Sponsorships
