PTSA Event or Program Subsidy Policy

The PTSA shall run a subsidy program (also referred to as a scholarship), for the purpose of encouraging engagement from a student for whom fees are a financial hardship to participate in PTSA programming, according to the following procedures:

1. Examples of events or programs that may offer subsidies include, but are not limited to: All Night Grad Party, Senior Yard Signs, and Mock Exams
2. PTSA subsidies do not apply to school or district events.
3. Subsidies may cover a full or partial portion of the fees. The sources of these subsidy funds are:
 - a. Donations made by members or others for senior events. These donations are included in the “Senior Donations – Restricted” budget line and unused funds carry forward in the restricted budget line from year to year.
 - b. Proceeds from Yard Sign sales.
 - c. General funds from “Membership” or “Donations” budget line.
