- Service from January 1, 2023 to December 23, 2023
 - > 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 school year
- The Golden Acorn Award. The Issaquah High PTSA honors volunteer service and dedication to youth by awarding the Golden Acorn Award annually. This award recognizes PTSA members who volunteer in ways that meet the mission of PTA: promoting the health, welfare, safety and education of ALL youth in our school and community.
- The Outstanding Advocate Award. Every year the Issaquah High PTSA honors outstanding volunteer advocacy for youth by awarding the Outstanding Advocate Award. This award recognizes PTSA members for their advocacy and commitment in helping create strong policies relating to the health, welfare, safety and education of our youth.
- The Honorary Life Membership Award. The Honorary Life Membership Award recognizes an individual who has contributed significantly to the development, growth, and sustainability of a local PTA or council. It is awarded to someone who has shown extraordinary commitment to the PTA's vision and mission. Recipients receive a certificate and pin, and a contribution is made in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program that benefits students.
 - Note: Honorary Life Membership Award recipients do not receive a free membership in the PTA that gives the award; recipients of this award need to continue to purchase their own PTA membership annually.


