Standing Rules

The Purpose of Standing Rules (show Proposed Standing Rules)

1. Standing Rules are specific conditions and rules the Issaquah High PTSA (IH PTSA) has chosen to impose upon itself.
2. Standing rules must not conflict with the WSPTA Uniform Bylaws.
3. In case of conflict, the Uniform Bylaws will be considered superior to Standing Rules.
4. Standing Rules should be reviewed, updated, and approved at the first general meeting each year.
5. Standing rules may be amended at any time by a vote of the membership, provided that quorum is present
 1. Quorum is defined here and by the WSPTA Uniform Bylaws as at least ten (10) paying members of the IH PTSA
6. Notice of a vote to amend shall be given no less than thirty (30) days in advance by the current President of the IH PTSA
 1. If notice is given a simple majority of the quorum is required to pass the amendment
 2. If no notice is given a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority of the quorum is required to pass the amendment
 3. Results of the vote shall be recorded in the official minutes by the Secretary.

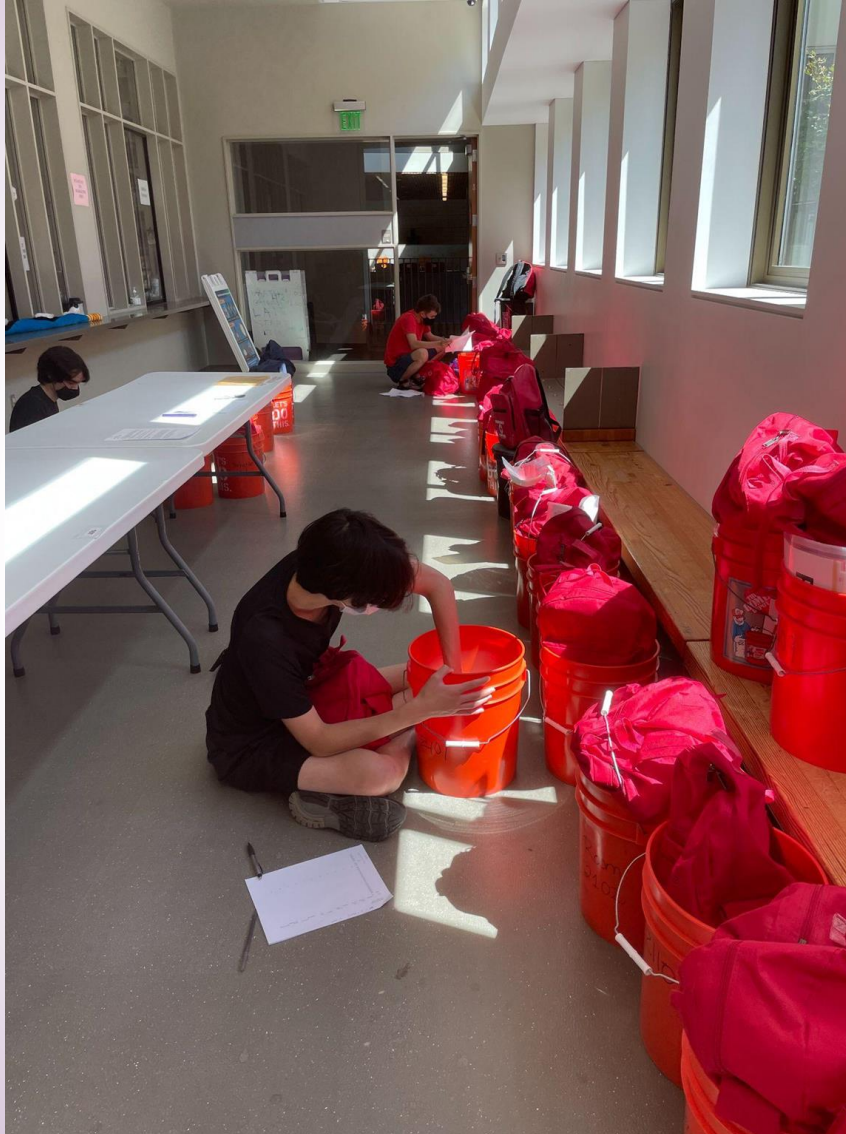

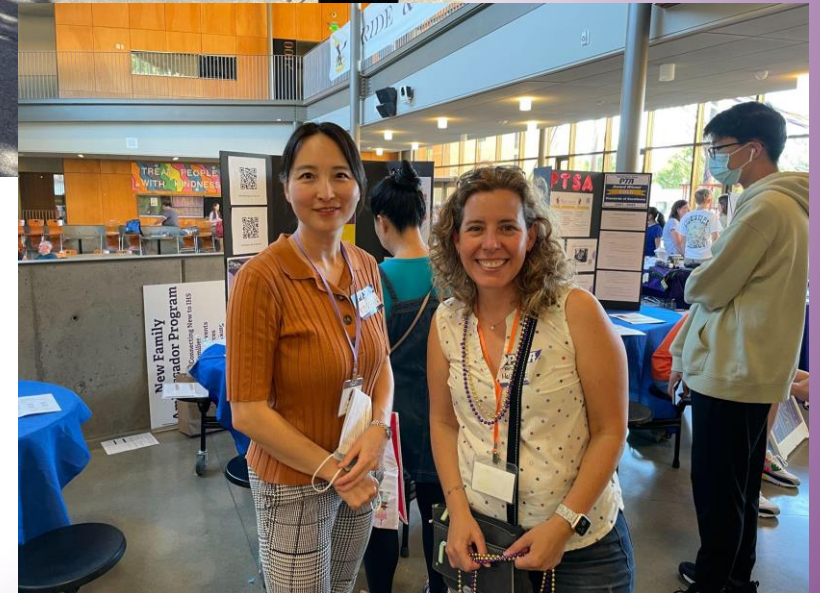
