

The Nominating Committee update



Article 5, Section 6 from the WSPTA Uniform Bylaws: Officers and their election.

A. Each local PTA shall have at least four elected officers: president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer. Other officers may be specified in the local PTA standing rules.

B. The local PTA officers shall be elected by ballot prior to the end of the fiscal year for a term of one year and until their successors are elected. A majority vote is necessary to elect. The election may be by voice vote if only one candidate is nominated for an office.

C. A member may not serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office. An officer having served eight or more months shall be considered to have served a full term.

The Nominating Committee update



Article 5, Section 6 from the WSPTA Uniform Bylaws: Officers and their election.

D. Officers shall assume their duties on July 1 in the year elected.

E. To be elected to office in a local PTA, a person shall be at least 18 years of age. The person shall have been a member of any local PTA for at least 15 days preceding the election. Persons joining at the organizational meeting of a new local PTA shall be entitled to privileges of membership including voting and election to office.

According to our Standing Rules, the Executive Committee shall consist of the elected offices of President, Secretary, Treasurer, (non-signer) Assistant Treasurer, Vice President Hospitality, Vice President Communications, Vice President Events, Vice President Outreach, and Vice President Programs. Any elected position, except Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, may be held by two (2) people.




