



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IH PTSA Grant Proposal Questions

(1) Describe Grant proposal, in detail.

This lunch group is being put together to support students with social/communication disabilities gain a lunch group to eat with 2x a month. Many of these students eat alone daily. The function of the lunch is to promote social engagement with other students and help them gain the social skills to support the formation of friendships. These lunches will be supervised by the school social worker, support staff, and or other certificated staff in the building who will provide a structure and sometimes social lessons for the group.

So many of our students are eating lunch alone because they don't know how to approach others to join them for lunch, or are uncomfortable doing so. This is especially true in our post-pandemic social climate.

(2) Itemized costs, including tax and shipping. Attach Grant quotes.

Weekly pizza and beverages for up to 12 individuals, about \$90 weekly. For the rest of first semester, 7 weeks x \$90 = \$630.

(3) Grant timeline?

We have been using the leftover funds from the 2021-22 grant, but that fund is now empty. We would use this renewed grant money as early as December 1, 2022.

(4) How will Grant foster student learning?

These students will gain social skills such as turn taking, commenting, asking and answering questions, sharing opinions, and making friends.

(5) How will Grant support and strengthen IHS school community?

These are some of our most vulnerable students who have no connection to others. This will provide a sense of belonging and a drive to seek out others for support/ compassion/understanding.

(6) How does Grant align with IH PTSA mission?

This program will foster the social environment at Issaquah high school.

(7) How many students, and which populations will specifically benefit from Grant?

LRC 1 students with social/ communication IEP goals or deficits. Approx. 25 students

(8) Long-term Grant impact on our students and IHS?

This program allows students to find a friend group and support system. This will follow them throughout their lives.

(9) Is this Grant a one-time expenditure? If not, how will Grant funded in future?

We would like to request that it be an ongoing initiative that is added to the IHPTSA annual budget.



If you are a Senior, how important is it to you that some kind of All Night Graduation Party occurs, whether or not it is similar to past ones?




