




PTSA donors provide food for the monthly staff breakfasts.

New Family Connections (year-round)








PTSA New Family Connections sponsors year-round social activities for parents and guardians, especially those new to the area. Whether new or not, all are invited to come make new friends!

IHS students have placed at the state and national levels in this PTSA Competition.







Staff Appreciation Week (May)






PTSA loves our staff and shows it during

Senior Events (June)


