2018 All Night Grad Party Information Sheet

June 18, 2017 - Graduation and All Night Grad Party

The All Night Grad Party will be held the night of graduation, departing from Issaquah High School.

Please read following instructions.

- CHECK IN FOR ALL NIGHT GRAD PARTY: Check in for the All Night Grad Party will occur at Issaquah High School beginning at 9:30pm. Graduates will check in at the table for their bus color in the IHS Commons. We will depart IHS for our first venue around 10:30pm. We will return to Issaquah High School at approximately 6:00 AM on Tuesday 6/19.
- TRANSPORTATION TO & FROM IHS: For safety purposes graduates will not be allowed to drive themselves home after the all-night event. Graduates must be dropped off at Issaquah High School for the party and picked up at Issaquah High School on Tuesday at 6am. There will be no exceptions to this safety precaution.
- EVERY GRADUATE WILL GO THROUGH A SECURITY CHECK BEFORE GETTING ON THE BUS: A patdown will be conducted by a same-gender volunteer before any graduate boards a bus. Shoes, hats and personal items will all be inspected. Prohibited items (see below) will be confiscated and stored in a bag with your name on it and will be returned the following morning when you get off the bus back at the high school. Anyone refusing the pat down will not be allowed to board the bus.
- ANYONE DISPLAYING INAPPROPRIATE OR DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR or believed to be in possession or under the influence of drugs or alcohol, will not be allowed to board the bus and/or will be removed from the event. Parents will be called to pick up their graduate. If parents are unavailable, police will be contacted and no refunds will be given. This is true for the entire evening. Good conduct will make for a carefree night.

Prohibited Items:

<u>Leave the following items at home – hands free is worry free!</u>

- Alcohol, drugs or tobacco products of any kind
- Cell phone (in case of emergency, parent chaperones will have phones)
- Beverage bottles or any food items if you have a severe food allergy please contact Nicci Allen
- Electronics You will not have any time to use them and there is no way to ensure their safety
- Cameras. Photos will be taken by GN and chaperones to capture the event the entire evening.
- Purses (personal hygiene items, first aid, mints and gum will be available in the restrooms or from a chaperone)

CANCELLATIONS: If something unexpected happens that day and you cannot attend the event, call Nicci

Allen at 775-223-9239 or Michael Allen at 775-223-9231 by 5:00 PM. Please leave a detailed message or send a text if there is no answer so we can account for your student. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide refunds.

Emergency Medicine: Bring your epi-pen, inhaler, insulin or other emergency medication in prescription pharmacy packing, only if the items have been previously noted on your release. You may hold on to your own emergency medication. Carol Jongejan will have over the counter medications available by request (aspirin, Advil etc.)

Wear comfortable clothing: it will be an active evening and comfortable clothing/shoes are recommended. Closed toe shoes with socks are recommended. Please consider bringing a long sleeve shirt or sweatshirt, as the temperatures drop at night, even if the weather is nice.

Check-in Procedures: Please arrive at the Issaquah High School Commons at 9:30pm on Monday evening, June 18. Students must check in at the check in tables arranged by bus color. Students will be given a wristband with your bus color to wear all evening. Only IHS graduates with wristbands that match their bus color will be allowed on each bus. We are unable to switch bus assignments that evening. Please find your bus color and stand in line for check in, wrist bands and the pat-down. Buses will depart at 10:30 for our first location.

A professional police security officer will be present at the venues throughout the evening. Chaperones will ride the buses with the graduates and are available at each venue. All chaperones will be wearing the same identifiable wrist bands that we will show you at check in. Please feel free to approach any chaperone if you have a question, have a friend with a medical issue, need access to check in items or just say to say "Hi". Each venue will be staffed by event people to run activities and answer questions.
