



What is the All Night Grad Party?

All Night Grad Parties are like a rite of passage in the greater Seattle area and have been happening the night of graduation at hundreds of high schools for decades.

Any graduating senior at Issaquah High School is invited to purchase a ticket and attend. This once-in-a-lifetime-event was created to be a safe place for the graduating class to gather one last time in a secure location(s) and provide an alcohol-free, entertainment-filled celebration. This party is all inclusive meaning all venue costs, food, drink, entertainment, transportation, supervision, prizes, surprises, and more are all included in the ticket price. The consistent feedback from graduating seniors is that kids never regret attending their All Night Grad Party and it's a super way fun to honor 12+ years of hard work. The seniors are intentionally given very few details in order to maintain an element of surprise and ultimate fun!

How Does the All Night Grad Party Work?

Immediately following the graduation ceremony at T-Mobile Park, the seniors with a purchased ticket for the All Night Grad Party will be expected to change their clothes (unfortunately there is not a space provided inside the park, and this will have to happen in the car) and meet outside T-Mobile to board motor coach buses. Prior to graduation, the seniors will have the opportunity to select a friend or group of friends to ride the bus with on grad night. Seniors will not be allowed to bring any belongings with them except a sweatshirt and their phone/portable charger. Everything else they could possibly need will be provided for them (pre-arranged exceptions can be made with the party chairs for food allergies).

The buses will depart for the first secret location where tons of fun await the seniors, and food and beverages will be served. There will be an area designated for those students who wish to escape the energy of the evening as needed. Chaperones are stationed strategically so that nobody can enter or leave the premises maintaining a safe space for the seniors. Later in the night, seniors will board the buses again and head to a second secret location for more fun! Buses will return the seniors to IHS at 5am Tuesday 6/18. Seniors are not allowed to leave a car at IHS overnight and are expected to have an adult pick them up to ensure a safe ride home after being up all night.

What is the Cost of the Grad Party?

Tickets have been on sale since the online registration process in August and early bird pricing ended 3/1/24. The price for an All Night Grad Party ticket is \$225 which again, is all inclusive and covers 7 hours of action packed fun. Partial or full scholarships are available and confidential. Unfortunately we can not offer refunds for this event. 100% of the proceeds from ticket sales goes directly to fund this party and it is not a fundraiser for the PTSA.
